*Gowning at Court*

---

1. Gowning by counsel is only required in proceedings in which oral evidence is being called.
2. Judges will continue to gown for all matters (except for regularly scheduled civil, criminal, and family chambers), but may exercise their discretion not to do so for brief appearances.
3. Gowning by judges or counsel is not required for regularly scheduled civil, criminal, and family chambers.
