

Court of Appeal of Yukon Practice Directive (Civil) Order Made When Extension of Time Refused

When an application to extend the time to file an appeal record, transcript, appeal book or appellant's factum has been refused by a justice in chambers, the order shall include a direction that the appeal is dismissed as abandoned. If there is a reason why the appeal should not be dismissed as abandoned, counsel should raise the issue at the hearing. The order should also indicate any disposition as to costs.
