*Chambers - Civil, Family and  
Maintenance Enforcement*

1. There will continue to be Chambers on every Tuesday on which there is a judge available. When Monday is a holiday, the Chambers will be held on Wednesday.
2. **Family Chambers and Maintenance Enforcement Chambers** will be held from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
3. **Civil Chambers** will be held from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
4. **Appearance Day** will be held from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
5. Consent adjournments will be spoken to first followed by consent orders and contested matters.
6. No later than 3:00 p.m. the preceding Monday, (or in the event Monday is a holiday, on Tuesday), the parties or their counsel or agent will contact the Clerk to confirm the status of their matter. The Clerk will take adjourned matters off the list and separate non-contested matters from contested matters and note the time which it is anticipated each matter will take. If no one contacts the Clerk about a matter by 3:00 p.m., it shall be struck from the list.
7. **Divorces** will be heard on non-Chambers days.
