Criminal Fix Date Chambers

Criminal trial dates will be fixed by a Judge in Chambers at 1:30 p.m., one Tuesday a month.

Parties or their counsel who have trials to be fixed will be expected to appear in Chambers at 1:00 p.m. to speak to the list with the Trial Coordinator. The judge may require a pre-trial conference before fixing the trial date.

Accused persons who have been committed to stand trial will be given the attached "Letter of Notification" form by the Territorial Court Clerk before leaving the Courtroom at the completion of the Preliminary Inquiry. A copy will be handed to counsel for the accused at the same time.
