*Gowning at Court*

---

1. Gowning by counsel is only required for:
  - a) trials and hearings of petitions;
  - b) motions where oral evidence is to be called; and
  - c) summary conviction and statutory appeals.
2. Judges will continue to gown for all matters (except for regularly scheduled civil, criminal and family chambers), but may exercise their discretion not to do so for brief appearances.
3. Gowning is not required for regularly scheduled civil, criminal and family chambers.
