Civil Rules and Forms

The judges of the Supreme Court of Yukon are authorized by s. 38 of the *Judicature Act*, R.S.Y. 2002, c. 128, to make rules of practice and procedure in civil and criminal matters. Prior to September 15, 2008, the Rules of Court for the Supreme Court of British Columbia were in force. Effective September 15, 2008, the new Rules of Court for the Supreme Court of Yukon will be in force for all civil matters.

The final version of the Rules and Forms, both English and French, is now available on the court's website at www.yukoncourts.ca.

You will find them under Yukon Rules and Forms (Règles de procédure et formules) on the left side of the screen. The current link to the British Columbia Rules and Forms and the Divorce Rules and Forms will remain for the time being for precedent value.

The Rules are available on a Rule by Rule basis or as one document containing all the Rules in a PDF format. The same applies for the Forms. The Forms will be available as Word documents in the near future.

Please note that all previous copies of the Rules and Forms on CD-ROM are not to be used, as many changes have been made since those CDs were released for consultation purposes.
