*Children's Act – Approval of Orders*

---

All orders of the Court made pursuant to the *Children's Act* must be approved in writing by all parties or their counsel. The signatures of parties or their counsel should appear under the endorsement: "Approved as the order made."

Consent orders shall be styled "Consent Order" and the endorsement shall read: "Consented to and approved as the order made."

Where it would be impractical to require the signature of a party, an application may be made to the issuing judge for an order dispensing with the signature requirement.
