Use of Electronic Equipment in Court Registry

Due to the small size of the court registry's public waiting area, mobile devices may not be used for audio or video calls within this area. Such calls may be conducted in the atrium of the courthouse, provided that they are not disruptive to other courthouse users.

Mobile phones may be used within the court registry's public waiting area when operated silently, including for communication by text message or email.

In addition, individuals may use the camera function on a mobile device to take photos of court documents and exhibits that are otherwise available for copying by the public.
