

IN THE TERRITORIAL COURT OF YUKON

PRACTICE DIRECTION CP-21

Bail Court

Unless otherwise directed by the presiding judge or justice of the peace, bail matters, whether held by phone, video, or in person shall be called in the following sequence:

- 1. adjournments;
- 2. consent releases:
- 3. contested hearings.

Unless otherwise agreed to, contested hearings will be called in order of seniority of counsel based on date of call to the bar (of any jurisdiction).

Counsel shall contact the Trial Coordinator's Office in advance or advise the presiding judge or justice of the peace if a contested matter is expected to be lengthy (e.g. one hour or more). If counsel have not already done so, the Court may direct counsel to consult the Trial Coordinator's Office to seek a special time for the hearing.

This Direction supersedes instruction contained within TECH-6 (Video Remand Appearances), specifically paragraph 4, for bail hearings only. See also Practice Direction CP-3 (Telephone Appearance by Counsel).
