Circuit Cancellation Due to Weather

Where the weather forecast raises concerns about whether travel to a circuit may be hazardous, including temperatures below -35 degrees Celsius, the Court will contact all parties on the circuit distribution list by phone, email or in-person meeting, to discuss whether the circuit will proceed. The presiding judge will make a determination by noon the day before the scheduled circuit. Where the presiding judge cancels the circuit due to weather conditions, Practice Direction CP-7 (Conduct of Circuit by Telephone) applies.

Where the judge does not cancel the circuit, but the court party is nonetheless unable to attend due to weather conditions, the presiding judge will give direction as to how the circuit will proceed.
