PRACTICE DIRECTION GENERAL-22

Co-counsel/second chairs

Counsel must be called to the bar of the Yukon or have a certificate of permission to act from the Law Society of Yukon in order to provide legal services to clients in the Yukon (*Legal Profession Act, 2017*, or the Law Society of Yukon Rules 2020).

Counsel who have not complied with these legal requirements shall not be permitted to appear in the Supreme Court of Yukon in any capacity. This includes appearing in person, by telephone or video-conference. It also includes counsel who are co-counsel or second chair even if they do not make submissions at the hearing. Counsel who have not complied with the requirements will not be permitted to appear as counsel of record on any written rulings or judgments.
