PRACTICE DIRECTION GENERAL - 23

Form of Address and Pronouns for Parties. Witnesses and/or Counsel

This Practice Direction clarifies how parties, witnesses, and/or counsel can advise the Court, other parties, and counsel of their form of address and pronouns.

At the beginning of any proceeding when parties or counsel are introducing themselves, their client, a witness, or another person, they should provide the judge or justice with each person's name, title (e.g. "Mr./Ms./Mx./Counsel Jones") and the correct pronouns to be used in the proceeding.
