NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION AND PUBLIC COVID-19


March 18, 2022

The Yukon government ended the state of emergency on March 18, 2022, and the COVID-19 pandemic mandatory restrictions are no longer in effect.

The Supreme Court of Yukon continues to prioritize the safety and health of all participants in the court system. The courts are in a unique position because people who attend courts are often required or compelled to be present. The community served by the courts includes many vulnerable people. To ensure the safety of all court participants while COVID-19 is still circulating in our territory, there is an ongoing need to keep restrictions and measures in place.

The restrictions and policies set out in the Supreme Court of Yukon COVID-19 notice dated February 28, 2022, will stay in place until further notice.
