Written Submissions Filed Outside of Scheduled Hearing

From time to time on a matter, judges will request that written submissions be filed by the parties, outside of the scheduled hearing. These could relate to for example, costs, clarification of an issue on a matter after a hearing has occurred, or a new case decided after a hearing that may affect the outcome of the matter.

In these circumstances, when the written submissions are brought to the Court Registry for filing, counsel or the party must attach a note to the submissions stating that they are to be sent directly to the judge and specifying which judge.
