The Court of Appeal of Yukon maintains the court record from its registry located in Whitehorse, Yukon. As such, all documents relating to Yukon appeals must be filed in the Whitehorse registry unless otherwise directed.

Appeals are to be heard in Yukon. In exceptional cases where an appeal must be heard without delay, parties may request a hearing outside of the regular assizes by writing the Registrar in Whitehorse and explaining the circumstances. If an earlier hearing is warranted, efforts will be made to have the matter heard in Whitehorse at a different time. If this is not possible, the appeal will be heard in Whitehorse with the Justices of the Court of Appeal appearing virtually.

Lawyers are reminded that they must be called to the Bar in the Yukon or have a certificate of permission to act from the Law Society of Yukon to appear in Yukon Court of Appeal matters.
