



**NOTICE TO PUBLIC AND PROFESSION – COVID-19 UPDATE
Mask-wearing**

June 3, 2022

With the reduction in reported COVID-19 cases throughout the Yukon, the mandatory mask requirement currently in place in the courtrooms, courthouse, the Law Library and the registry will be removed effective June 27, 2022.

The presiding Judge retains discretion to require people to wear masks in the courtrooms at any hearing. Counsel and self-represented individuals may also request in advance of the hearing that masks be worn. Anyone attending the courthouse, courtrooms, Law Library or registry may choose to wear a mask at any time.

The COVID-19 restrictions in numbers of people attending the courtrooms, the Law Library and the registry are lifted.

Hand sanitizer will continue to be available in the courtrooms and courthouse.
