Yukon Judicial Council (the "Council") invites applications for the position of Territorial Court Judge in the Yukon.

To qualify for appointment to the Yukon Territorial Court, an Applicant must:

- be a member of the Law Society of Yukon, or be qualified to be a member of the Law Society of Yukon;
- have practiced law for a minimum of ten years in Canada immediately preceding the date of application, or have other equivalent legal experience satisfactory to the Council; and
- be proficient in English.

The Council will consider as an Asset:

- knowledge of French;
- experience living and working in northern communities; and
- experience working with and/or knowledge of Indigenous communities in Canada.

This appointment, while primarily hearing criminal law matters, will also involve the adjudication of matters under territorial legislation, Small Claims Court civil matters, judicial dispute resolution, child protection, presiding in therapeutic courts, Youth Justice Court, Justice of the Peace education, and extensive travel to communities (by road and by plane) throughout the Yukon.
