Conduct of Circuits Remotely

Scheduled circuits may be conducted by teleconference or videoconference at the discretion of the presiding judge where no substantive matters are expected to be heard or where the weather would make travel unsafe. See Practice Direction ADMIN-5 (*Circuit Cancellation Due to Weather*).

When a scheduled court circuit is conducted by teleconference or videoconference, the court registry will make the necessary arrangements with the community to ensure that the venue is set up with the necessary technology. Participants may attend at the community venue to join the teleconference or videoconference or attend at the courthouse in Whitehorse where the judge is presiding.
