Position of Counsel in Courtroom on Criminal Matters

For security reasons, in all criminal matters where the accused is present, defence counsel shall sit at the counsel table closest to the entryway which connects the Courtroom with the prisoner's cells. Crown counsel shall sit at the remaining counsel table.

Counsel wishing to change this placement should seek the leave of the Court.
