Court Start Time and Calling of the List

Judges and justices of the peace will be ready to start at the time set for all court appearances.

Adult docket court on Wednesdays and judges' docket court on Fridays will open thirty (30) minutes before the start time indicated on the docket with the following expectations:

- Crown counsel will be available for defence, courtworkers and clerks thirty (30) minutes before the start of court.
- Counsel and court worker lists will be presented to the clerk fifteen (15) minutes before the start of court.

Unless otherwise directed by the presiding judge or justice of the peace, counsel, whether appearing by phone or in person, will be called in order of seniority based on date of call to the bar (of any jurisdiction). See also Practice Directions CP-3 (*Telephone Appearances by Counsel*) and TECH-6 (*Video Remand Appearances*).

Failure to submit a Counsel List form will result in counsel's matters being called last.

All other courts will open fifteen (15) minutes before the start time indicated on the docket. If counsel wish to delay the start of court, they must advise the clerk and secure the permission of the presiding judge, otherwise court will be expected to start as scheduled.
