Signature of Counsel

The signature of counsel on any original document should be in writing. If counsel is unable to sign a document, another counsel may sign on his or her behalf by signing their own signature on the signature line, provided the author's name is indicated below the signature line. They should also legibly print their name and insert the word "for" before the author's name. See example below:

Jane Doe
Jane Doe *for* John Smith
Counsel for the Plaintiff.
