MEMORANDUM OF BAIL REVIEW DELIVERED FROM THE BENCH

[1] HUDSON J. (Oral): I had the opportunity to read the materials that have been filed. In this case, the delay might not even have been considered inordinate.

[2] In any event, on the submissions and the evidence contained in those submissions, there can be, in my view, no fault laid at the Crown.

[3] The circumstances of the aggression alleged against the complainant, and the circumstances of the failure to apparently comprehend the purpose of the family violence seminars the spousal violence proceedings that we went through, the circumstances of the breaches of recognizance in the past, and as alleged, persuade me that this is not a case where a change should occur with respect to the ruling made in the earlier bail application.
