**MEMORANDUM OF JUDGMENT
DELIVERED FROM THE BENCH**

[1] VEALE J. (Oral): I am concerned about Mr. Valihora serving the remaining number of days, going in Friday night and coming out Sunday morning. I do not know if that is convenient to the authorities. It lengthens the time he spends and it lengthens the number of weekends but it gives him more time off to earn money. I have made the sentence and the sentence is to serve on consecutive weekends.

[2] Mr. Valihora, some judges would not be able to help you in this matter, but I am prepared to make the change from Friday at 7:00 p.m. to Sunday at 6:00 p.m. or such other time as may be convenient to the Correctional facility, if you are interested
